JULY 16, TUESDAY

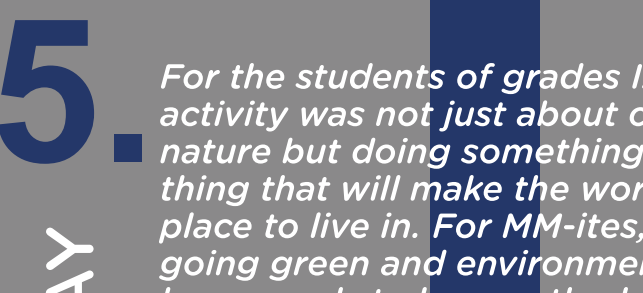

JULY 17, WEDNESDAY

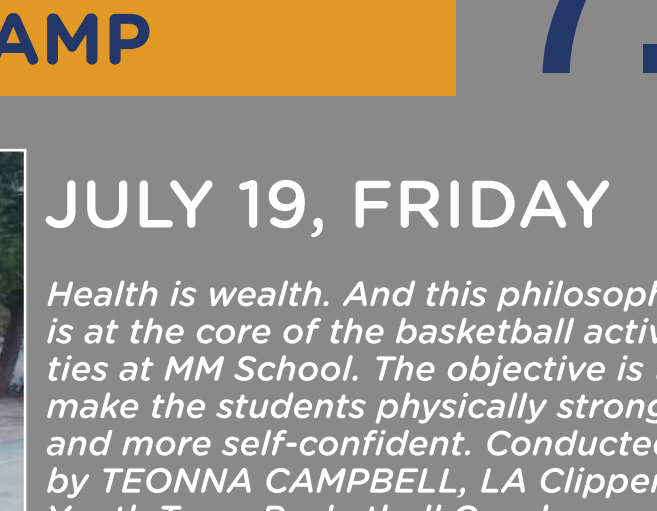

JULY 19, FRIDAY

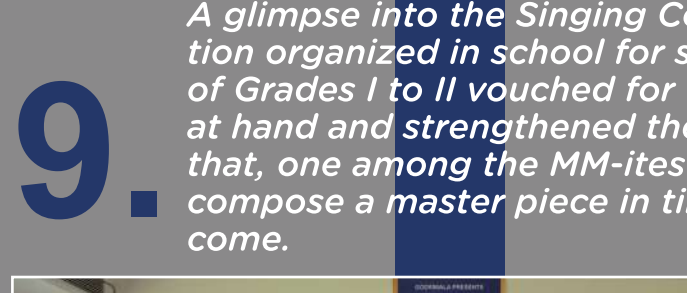

JULY 23, TUESDAY

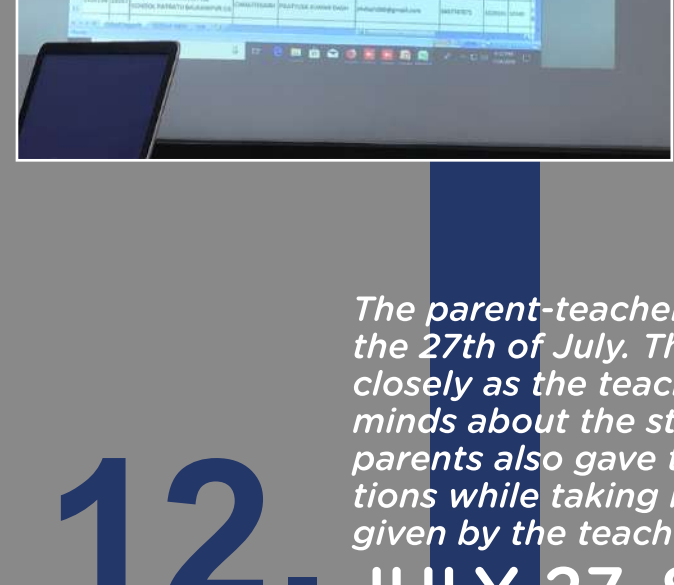

JULY 25, SATURDAY

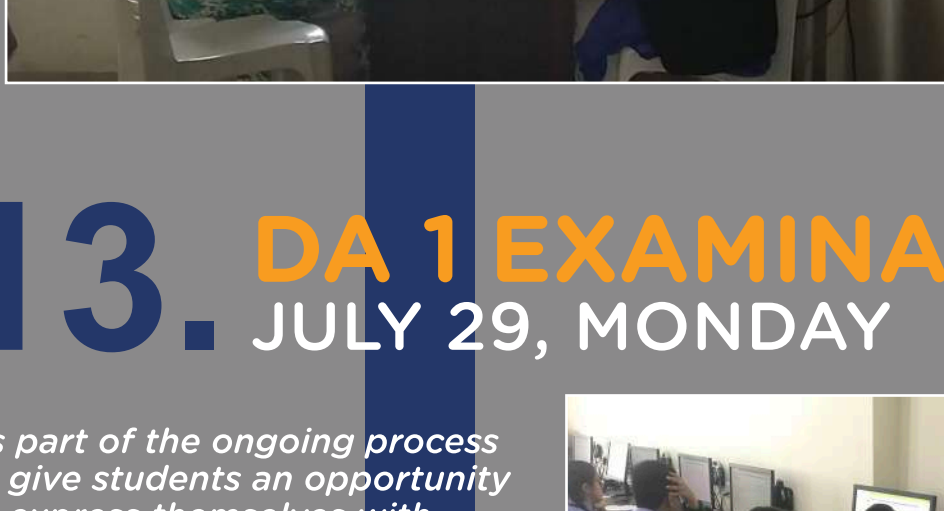

JULY 27, SATURDAY

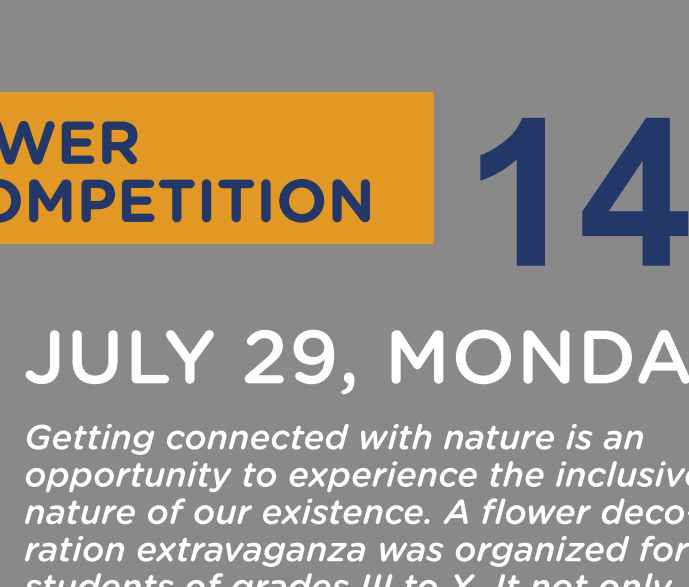

JULY 29, MONDAY

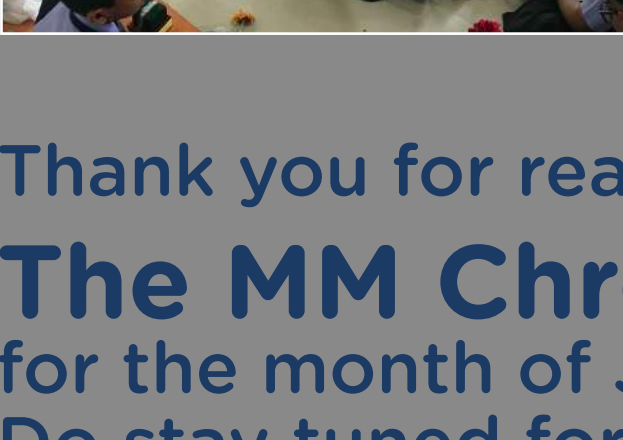
