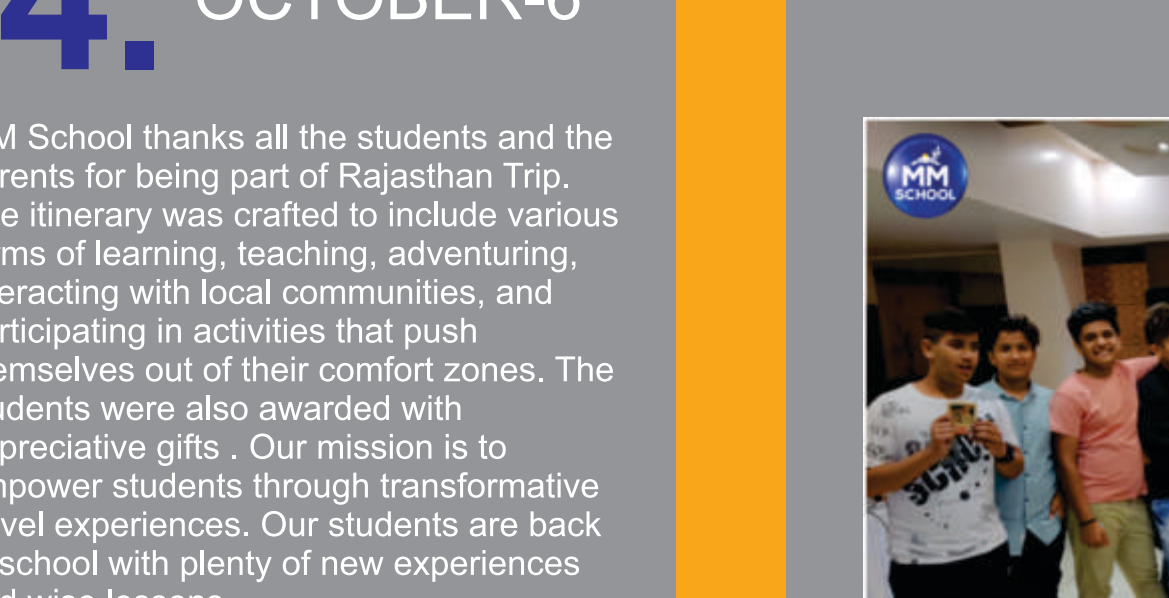

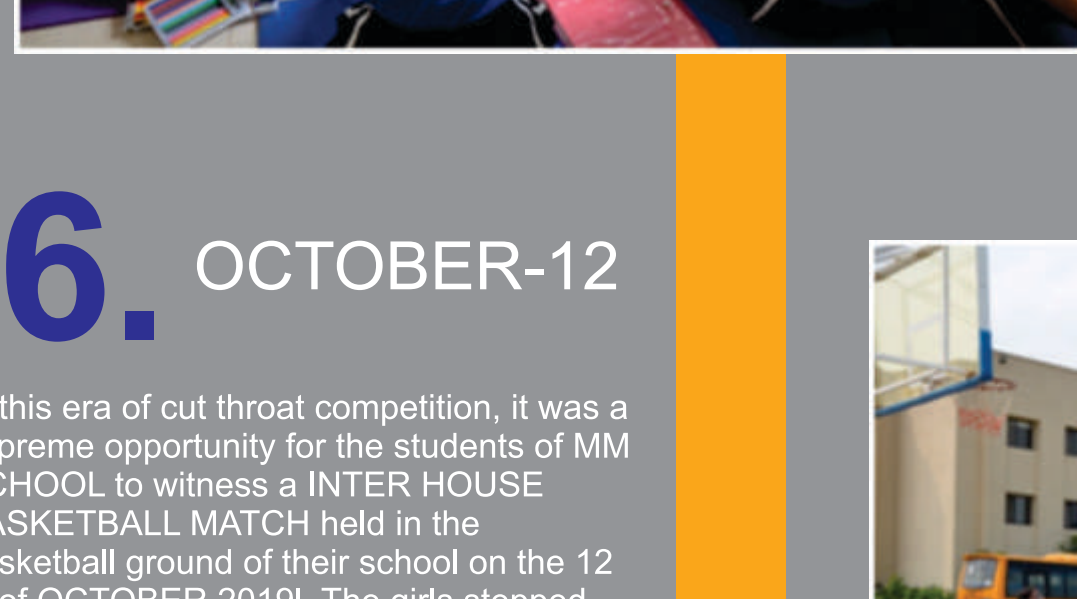
OCTOBER-6

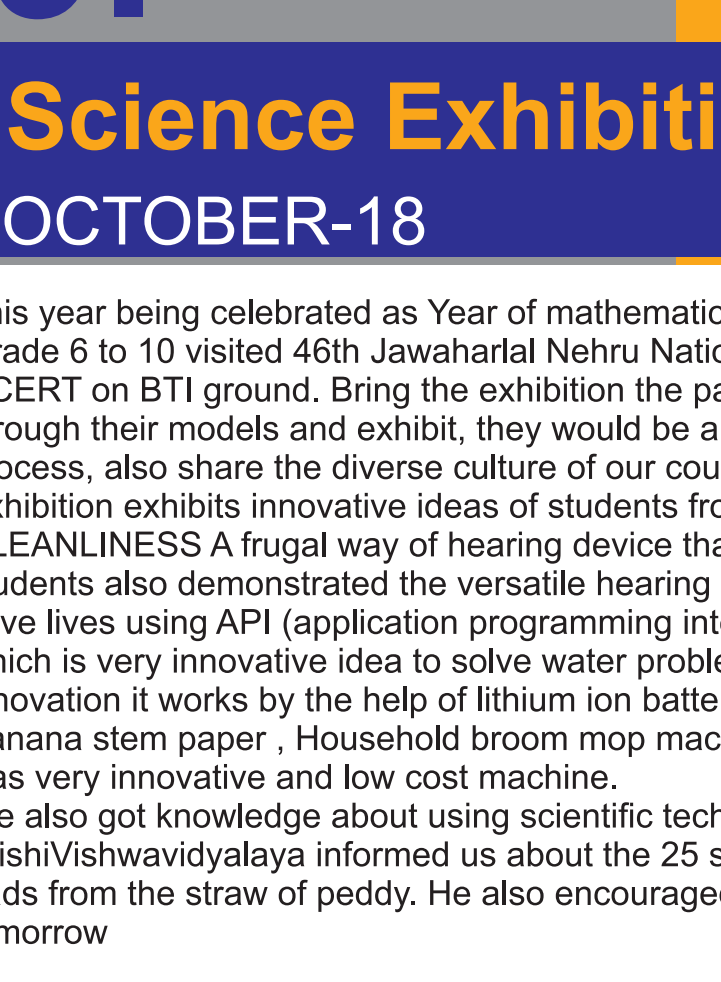

OCTOBER-19

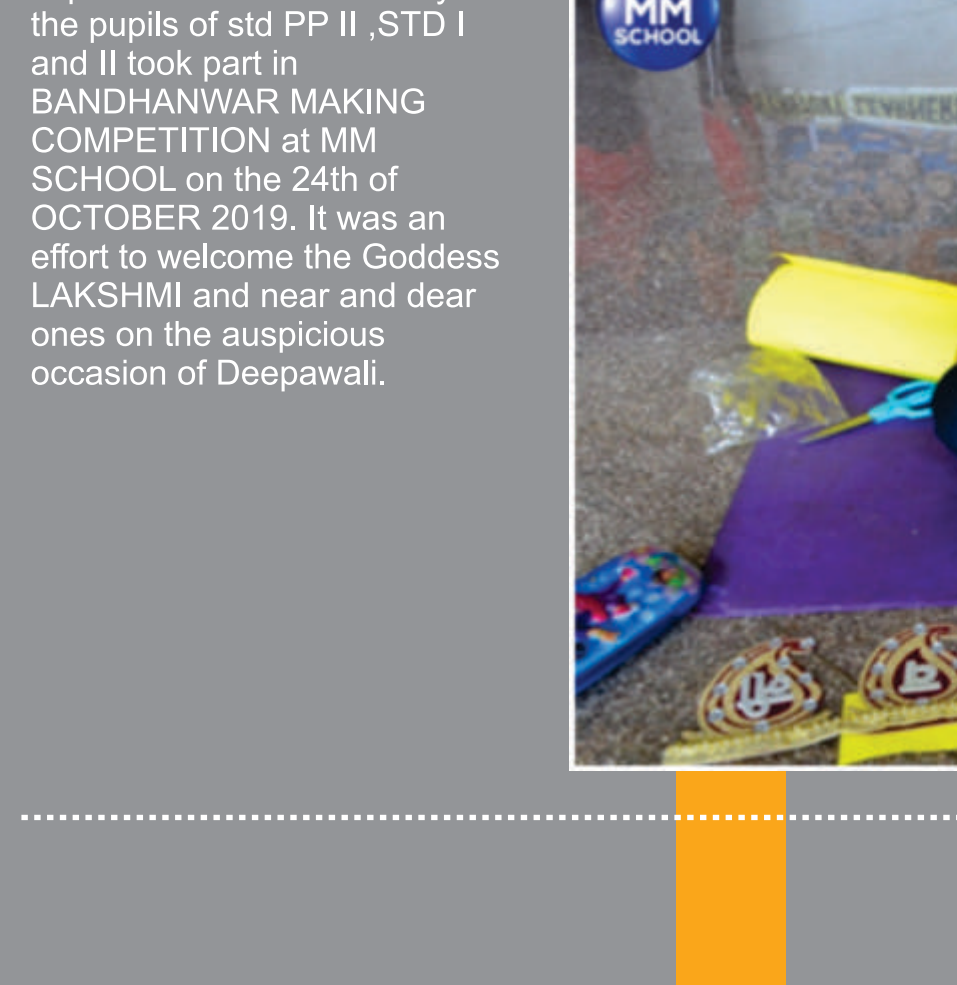

OCTOBER-24

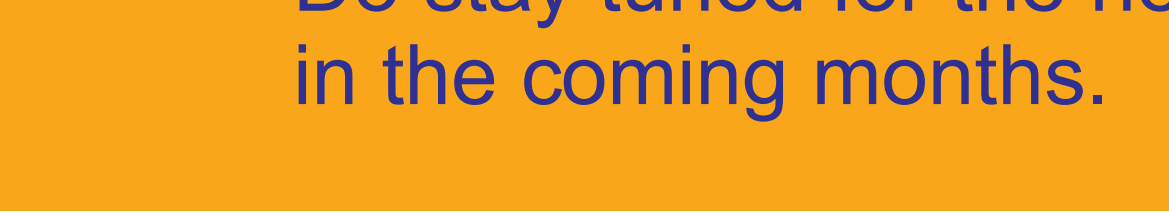
