The MM Chronicles brings to you a quick wrap-up of all the fun-filled activities and awesome events that we have over the past month

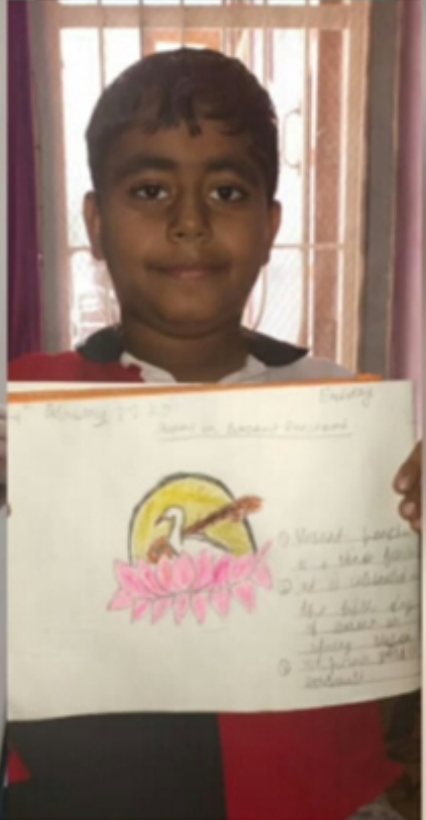
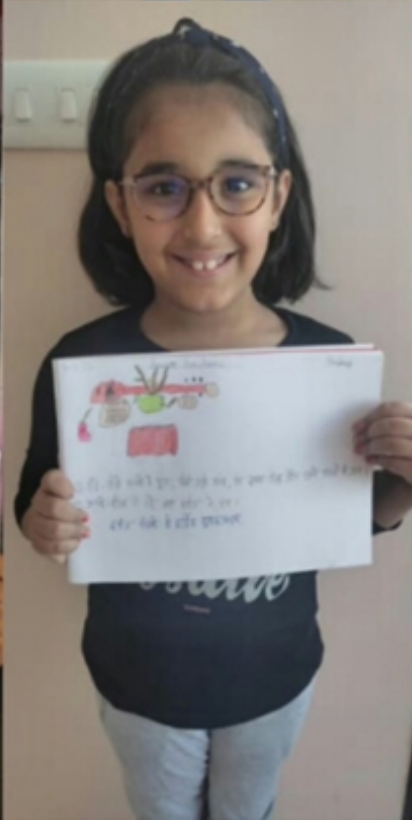
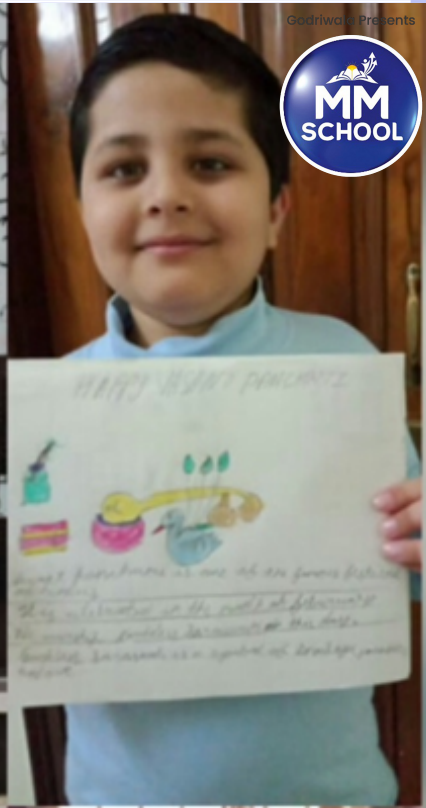
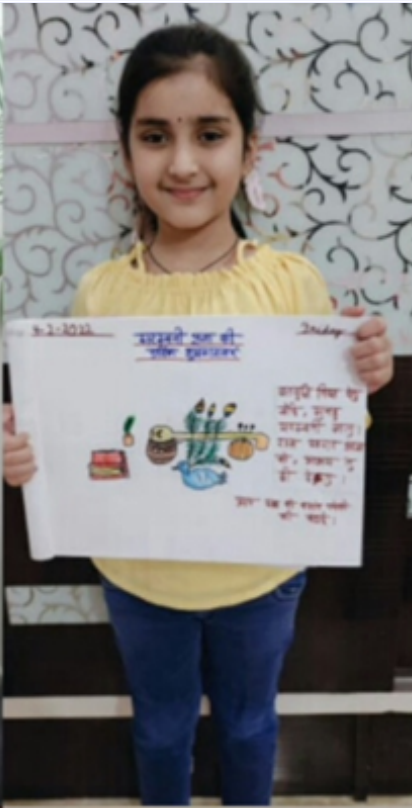
