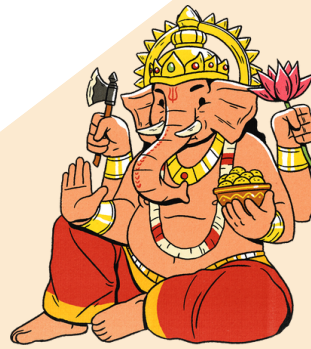

5th September 2022

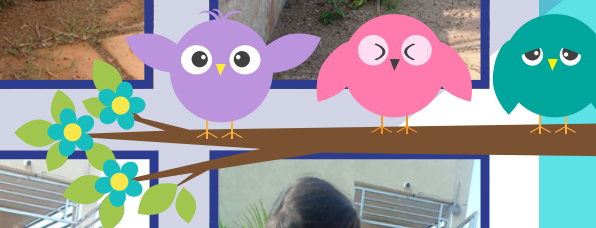
Teacher's Day was celebrated by all the students to honour their educators and recognize the effort that they put into shaping them as young individuals

Feeding birds makes a world of difference in an individual's life as well as for our planet. It helps to restore the balance of nature. Bird Feeding is a religious practice at MM School.

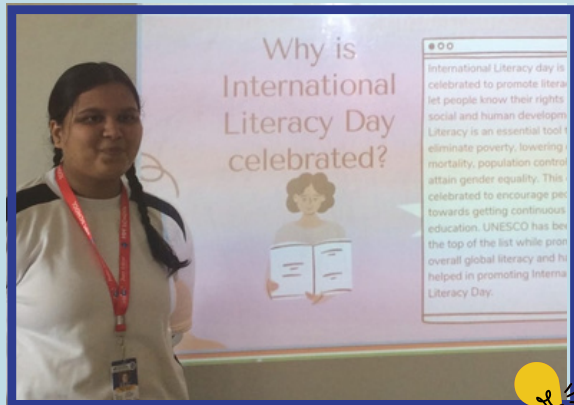
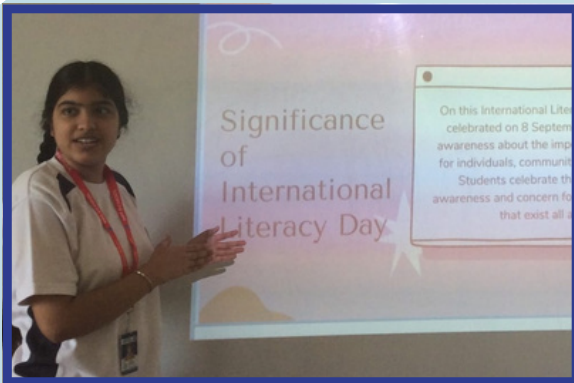




World Literacy Day.
