Whether it's language arts, math, science, or other subjects, journalism in the classroom offers a variety of benefits for students and teachers alike. In reflecting on their own thinking process, students will become adept at recognizing the importance of self-exploration, questioning, and connecting. When this reflection is in written form, students have a source of dialogue prepared for use during class discussions or when asking questions.

Unlike other educational institutions, we motivate the students to prepare their school journals in school itself, with peer collaboration.
