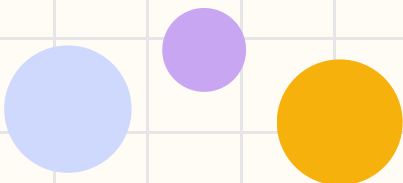

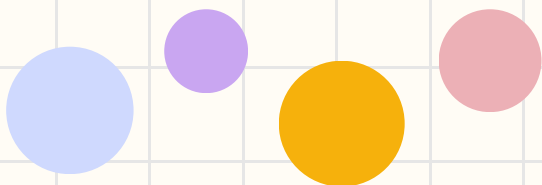


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## CHHATTISGARH FOUNDATION DAY

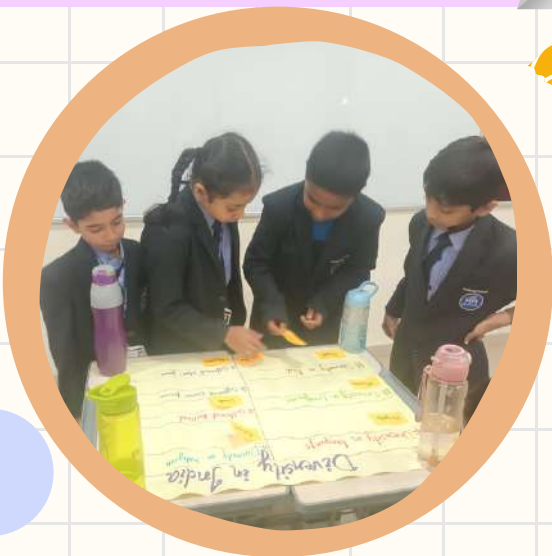
## EXPLORING THE COSMOS

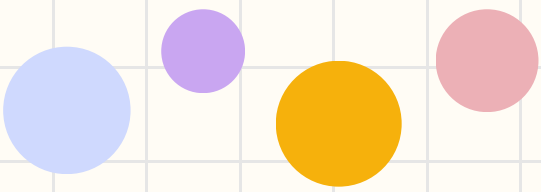
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**NOVEMBER'S GOLDEN STUDENTS ANNOUNCED**
