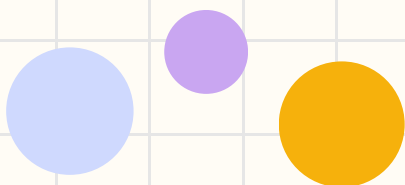

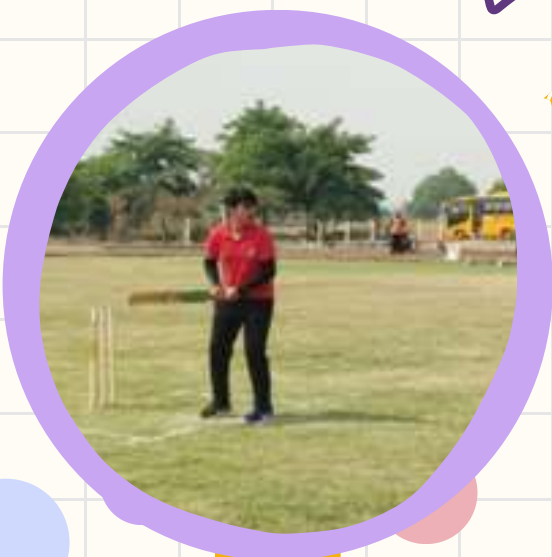
DIYA DECORATION COMPETITION
